

DAY 13 OF VIKSIT KRISHI SANKALP ABHIYAAN 2025

As part of the *Viksit Krishi Sankalp Abhiyaan (VKSA)*, the Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) Leh, in collaboration with CAZRI and other line departments, organized multiple training and awareness programmes to promote sustainable and scientific agriculture in Terchey, Skanpuk, Khardong, Tirth villages.

Experts shared knowledge on pest management, high-value vegetable production, year-round greenhouse cultivation, and seed production, particularly focusing on crops like European carrots and cucumbers. Emphasis was laid on organic farming practices such as vermicomposting, crop rotation, and mulching techniques to manage water scarcity.

Participants were also briefed on a wide range of government schemes, including:

- PM-Kisan, Kisan Credit Card (KCC), OSAP (Ranthak), Per Drop More Crop, and MIDH.
- Subsidies on greenhouses, polytrench farming, mushroom units (₹2 lakh subsidy), pack houses, and farm machinery.
- DBT-linked schemes and the revival of traditional water mills for sustainable practices.

From the Animal Husbandry Department, officials highlighted support like:

- 30% subsidy on cattle feed, 75% on yak, 100% on vaccinations and medicines.
- ₹40,000 monthly support for herders, provision of tents, milk frothers, and the role of artificial insemination in improving dairy output.

The sessions also covered value addition techniques for crops like tomatoes and apricots, agroforestry benefits, and the importance of pollination and pruning.

Overall, the events were interactive and informative, successfully equipping farmers with practical tools, technologies, and government support to enhance productivity and income in Ladakh's challenging agro-climatic conditions.
